Dr Hayman is a specialist anaesthetist working in Melbourne Australia. He graduated from medicine at the University of Sydney in 1997 and was awarded a fellowship of the Australian and New Zealand College of Anaesthetists in 2007. He works as a visiting specialist anaesthetist in Melbourne with appointments at Box Hill Public Hospital, St Vincent's Private Hospital, Epworth Richmond & Eastern Hospitals, Melbourne Private Hospital, Warringal Private Hospital and Knox Private Hospital. His major areas of clinical practice include:

- anaesthesia for cardiothoracic surgery
- anaesthesia for neurosurgery
- anaesthesia for cardiac electrophysiology procedures.

Dr Hayman also has expertise in the highly specialised procedures of transoesophageal echocardiography, cardiopulmonary bypass, and intra-operative neurophysiological monitoring.

Your pre-operative assessment

Dr Hayman will discuss the anaesthetic for your specific procedure with you prior to your operation. He will customise an anaesthetic plan incorporating considerations of your current medical condition and general health and the requirements of the planned procedure. When possible, he will meet you in person or alternatively speak with you on the phone prior to the day of surgery to explain what to expect and to answer any concerns related to your anaesthetic care and management. On the day of surgery he will meet you again to explain any further details and to give you an opportunity to ask questions before your operation.

Financial matters

In most instances Dr Hayman's fees will be covered by your health insurance, with a potential out-of-pocket 'known gap' payment. When a 'known gap' fee is charged, the maximum out-of-pocket expense will be \$500. If your insurance does not provide a 'no gap' or 'known gap' scheme then there may be a larger out of pocket expense. This will be explained to you prior to the procedure. Please do not hesitate to ask Dr Hayman for clarification.
